## A Record Year for Enrollment in the MPA Program

The 2009-2010 academic year was a record breaking one for the MPA Program. Fall and Winter Quarter enrollments were almost equal to the all-time records for those quarters and Spring Quarter enrollments were 152% of the previous Spring Quarter enrollment record. All in all, that meant that the 2009-10 academic year total enrollments were 29% above the average of the previous five years, 24% above last year and 6% above the previous record.
