The minor in Management Information Systems (MIS) provides the conceptual foundation and skill preparation for working in an Information Technology intensive environment characterized by electronic communications channels based upon microcomputer operating systems along with an in-depth knowledge of productivity software products. The program also provides an understanding of the business applications of these software products and demonstrates their importance in supporting business functions.
