BACHELOR OF ARTS IN BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION WITH MANAGEMENT MAJOR

A solid theoretical foundation balanced with practical application is critical to success in business. Eastern's business program provides that balance, with an emphasis on analysis, critical thinking and intellectual inquiry. Students also gain an understanding of economic, social, ethical and legal business environments along with principles of accounting, finance, management, marketing, production and quantitative analysis.

BACHELOR OF ARTS IN CHILDREN'S STUDIES EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION OPTION

Eastern Washington University is one of the first institutions to offer a children's studies major in the United States, representing a new interdisciplinary approach to the study of child populations based on the following set of principles:

- Childhood should be studied in its own right
- Children should be the units of observation
- Children should talk about their own experiences
- Childhood should be seen as part of the social structure
- Children should be studied in the present as well as in relation to their future as adults
- Childhood should be seen in an intergenerational context
- Individuals studying children should be open-mindedly looking for new theoretical and methodological developments

The curriculum of this interdisciplinary program focuses on the developmental, learning and social issues of children from birth to preadolescence. The children's studies major incorporates course work from multiple departments including Education, Sociology and Counseling, and Educational and Developmental Psychology.

Potential career opportunities include: child care lead provider, director and licensor, family child care provider, Head Start/ECEAP teacher, preschool teacher, private beginning school teacher and others working in various capacities with young children.

BACHELOR OF ARTS IN INTERDISCIPLINARY STUDIES SOCIAL AND BEHAVIORAL SCIENCES

Eastern's Bachelor of Arts degree in interdisciplinary studies is an accredited program taught face-to-face by experienced faculty from EWU and BCC. This degree program is ideally suited for students seeking career mobility, graduate school admission or individuals pursuing a degree completion program. Students will gain research and statistical skills as well as a solid foundation in the social sciences. The Interdisciplinary Studies curriculum includes courses derived from the following areas:

- Environment context
- Human diversity
- Large-and small-scale social organization
- Leadership studies
- Social control and resistance
- Social inequality

Credit for career experiences is also available for adult learners who have acquired university-level learning through their work experience. This process is conducted through the Prior Learning Assessment Option.

The Interdisciplinary Studies degree can be tailored to gain entrance to graduate schools, professional programs or a wide variety of career fields.



BACHELOR OF SCIENCE IN TECHNOLOGY APPLIED TECHNOLOGY OPTION

Eastern's Department of Engineering and Design provides students the technical background required for careers in business, industry or education. The department offers a variety of majors in areas, including engineering, technology and design. Faculty in the department have significant, related industrial experience. Direct articulation with industry results in programs that address the latest industry trends and provides graduates with excellent job placement and employment opportunities.
