Eastern Washington University's IFS provides students participating in intercultural exchanges with opportunities to increase their understanding of foreign people and places, develop confidence as world observers and gain an appreciation of higher education as an important partner in achieving future goals. Since the program began, traveling students have transferred more than 40,000 credits to the colleges or universities of their choice.

Working closely with educational travel program directors, Eastern Washington University has developed a series of courses corresponding with various travel itineraries. Courses have been designed to complement and enhance the educational value students receive from the program. IFS also offers postbaccalaureate, graduate credit for teachers and adult professionals at the discounted undergraduate price.
