Students who have earned a bachelor's degree or higher from an accredited US universities are not required to submit a credential evaluation. One copy of all official university transcripts or postsecondary academic records must also be sent directly to Graduate Studies, 206 Showalter Hall, Cheney, WA 99004-2444. International applicants who have already had a credential evaluation completed by WES or another credential service must have an official copy of that evaluation sent to Graduate Studies, along with official university transcripts.

Students from non-English-speaking countries must present a TOEFL score of 580 or its equivalent. A student with a TOEFL score between 550 and 579 may be admitted with the recommendation of the program and upon completion of an approved program of English language instruction. International students who have earned an undergraduate degree from an accredited postsecondary institution in the US are not required to submit a TOEFL score as part of their application.
