

**EWU School of Social Work – MSW Advanced Standing Program
 Full-Time Advanced Standing Course of Study**

The 51-credit advanced standing program for full-time students provides qualified BSW/BASW graduates a waiver for the MSW foundation content. Advanced standing students begin their studies with a summer advanced standing seminar and then join a current cohort of students to complete the MSW advanced generalist curriculum. Classes are offered at the Spokane University District campus, except the summer seminar. Advanced Standing students join a current cohort of students.
